On Tuesday 24th October, the Engineering Link Group visited Kadina High Campus to deliver their "Regional Engineering Project". We were joined by two staff from the Defence Force, Dr Ricardo Vasquez Padilla from Southern Cross University and two staff from the Engineering Link Group. This was a full day event in which students were given two half-day engineering challenges with practising engineers to solve problems using the principles of engineering.

The two challenges the students completed were the safe egg drop that involved designing and building a parachute to safely land an egg, and a Gearing challenge in which they had to design a gearing system to get a car to travel exactly 2 metres in 10 seconds.

All students gave great feedback about the day, and we look forward to hosting this event again next year.

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
















#### **Kadina High Campus**
